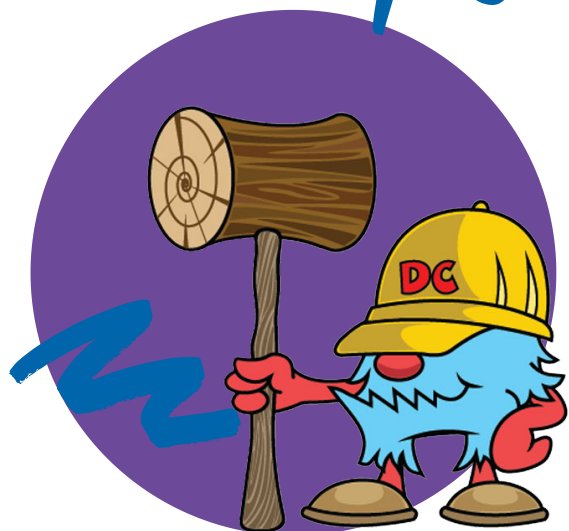

Logan has 5 stickers in his sticker book. He received 3 new stickers for his birthday. How many stickers does Logan now have all together?

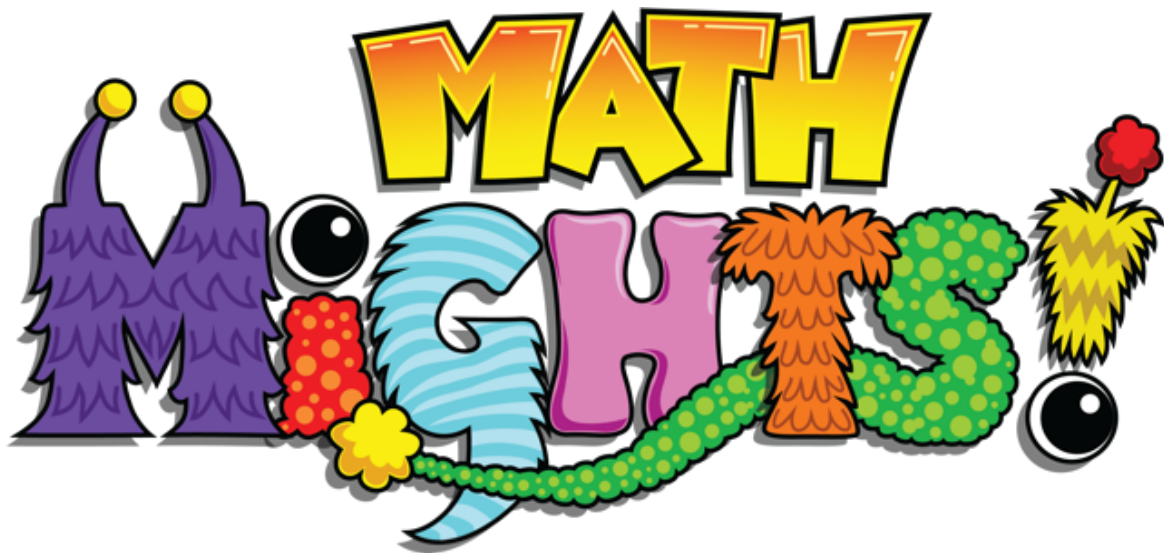
